

The Allington Ramble



A seven mile ramble through charming Lincolnshire countryside, on rarely-used roads and tracks, for which you should allow just over 3 hours

St. Swithun's Church

ROUTE

The first half of the walk follows the Viking Way.

On leaving St Swithun's Church turn left and follow Church Lane to the A1/Foston Road roundabout.

Here turn right and then immediately left to join the road that goes up and over the A1 – at **1** on map.

Follow the A1 exit around the corner and then turn right in 50 yards on to Sewstern Lane (Viking Way) – at **2** on map.





In about 1 mile – at **3** on the map – follow the Viking Way straight on as the road becomes a stone track.

In around a further mile and a half – at **4** on the map – turn left on to the road to Allington. Walk through Allington, past the Welby Arms on your right, following the road to the A1.

Then about 300 yards outside the village – at **5** on the map, turn left down a small road.

At the end of the road walk past some old farm buildings on your left on to a stone bridleway which in turn leads you back to the Viking Way.

Turn right on reaching the Viking Way and retrace the initial part of your route to return to Long Bennington and St Swithun's Church.

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Point 1 - A1/Foston roundabout.
You turn right then immediately left



Point 2 - Entering Sewstern Lane



Point 3 - Where you turn left to
walk towards Allington
